For In-Person Families:

This is another reminder of the current district protocol. Please note that any student with any of the following symptoms will be sent home immediately:

- Fever
- Cough
- Shortness of Breath
- New or Recent loss of smell or taste
- Sore Throat
- Nausea and/or Diarrhea

Note: Per district guidance, in addition to temperature screening, students will be asked: *“Before you left home this morning, did you have a cough, sore throat or runny nose?”* Students that respond with “Yes” will have to go home. Please note that the district has adjusted the question slightly.

To avoid any additional inconvenience to you, if they are experiencing any of the above listed symptoms, please keep them home. Our District Nurse, Alison Saylor, will follow up with you.

Great News! On August 31, 2020, the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) granted significant waiver extensions that allow all students to receive breakfast and lunch meals at no cost through December 31, 2020, regardless of free and reduced-price meals eligibility.

In January meal charges will return, therefore, families should still proceed with completing a Free and Reduced-Price Meals application at the start of the year.

All families that qualify for Free or Reduced Meals must complete a Free and Reduced meal application in order to have their student fees waived.
